Blunt nose inventory

The inventory of Boston terriers, English and French bulldogs and pugs are part of the Swedish Kennel Club's work against exterior exaggerations and the work to improve the health of these breeds. The project is a Nordic initiative and a similar inventory will also be carried out in Denmark, Norway and Finland.

The inventory, the practical part of which has now been completed, aims to create a better picture of each race's situation, genetic breadth and exterior variation. The hope is to find sufficient variation both externally and genetically to ensure the healthy development of these breeds with a reduction in BOAS-related health problems.

The project is run by SKK in close collaboration with race and special clubs. The inventory is aimed at dogs registered in SKK, in another kennel club and at unregistered dogs of these breed types. In the inventories arranged by breed clubs, other breeds are taken in if there is room.

During the inventory, the dogs have been described clinically by a veterinarian and externally by a descriptor (exterior judge). A swab sample has been taken in the dog's mouth, for the genetic analysis.

The information that emerges about the dog will **not** be registered in SKK's database but will only be used within the inventory project and for research.

From the start in the autumn of 2018, around 400 dogs have participated in the inventory. The results will now be analyzed and a compilation of these analyzes is expected to be completed in the spring of 2020.

Unhealthy dogs can be turned off

11 Feb 2019 Next year, dogs that are disqualified at a show due to ill health will risk being suspended from all forms of show, tests, competitions and breeding. The reason is that they want to prevent unhealthy dogs from being used in breeding.

Dogs have been disqualified due to ill health since 1998, but now SKK will increase the penalties. If the reason for the disqualification is difficulty breathing, the dog will be shut down with immediate effect. The dog owner can request a reconsideration of the decision. To lift the suspension, the dog must be examined by a specially designated veterinarian and must not show any clinical respiratory problems. For other health problems, the dog owner will receive a warning letter after two disqualifications that a third disqualified means permanent suspension.

The new rules will enter into force on 1 January 2020.
